Textile artist Estelle Bourdet brings considerable technical knowledge and dedication to her work, merging contemporary and analogue techniques. She is for example reviving the tradition of rag rugs, with a focus in all her pieces on slow production and sustainable resources, including the use of recycled materials.

This handmade bag is crafted from a single woven panel. Reflective PP cord and recycled twisted cotton thread are woven into the cotton warp, creating a unique and extremely durable structure. The bag is lined with a cotton pouch. A recycled paragliding cord with carabiner clip offers a way to secure keys or other valuable items. Thanks to the adjustable handle, the bag can be worn either over the shoulder or as a cross-body bag.

For the Circle of Friends edition and the exhibition *Textile Manifeste - von Bauhaus bis Soft Sculpture*, the avid weaver and mountaineer Estelle Bourdet has created a trusty and attractive companion.
